

Peninsula certification and adherence with the international sustainability & carbon certification (iscc) regime

- In line with its sustainability objective, Peninsula has taken a further step towards providing cleaner energy solutions in a responsible way by obtaining certification through the International Sustainability and Carbon Certification (ISCC) system.
- The ISCC EU certification awarded to the company entities Peninsula Petroleum Limited (PPL) and Peninsula Petroleum S.L. (PPSL) confirms its operations comply with the applicable requirements for biofuels according to the Renewable Energy Directive (RED II) (Directive (EU) 2018/2001 on the promotion of the use of energy from renewable sources (recast)). Additionally, PPL has also obtained certification under ISCC Plus regime as a for voluntary, non-regulated sustainability markets outside the European Union.
- This certification enables the traceability of the sustainable fuel through the supply chain and verifiable reduction of lifecycle emissions. As such, Peninsula can provide its customers with a portfolio of alternative fuel and energy source products that will help meet their own sustainability goals, and wider effort to transform the maritime sector as part of becoming a global climate-neutral economy.
- The ISCC EU certification allows Peninsula to supply its first biofuel bunker supply in 2023. This certification also enables the company to market other products such as bio or bio-circular.
- In the words of Kenny MacLean, COO of Peninsula, "we are proud to obtain the ISCC certification, which sets the global standard for biofuels supply and handling. We are highly motivated to work closely with the ISCC on optimising compliance and best practice, ensuring that our customers benefit from Peninsula's commitment to help decarbonise marine energy. Regular ISCC audits will assist Peninsula to hone its supply efficiency and operational excellence, all for the benefit of both our customers and the marine environment.
