ISCC Sustainability Statement on behalf of Peninsula Certified Entities for ISCC

In accordance with ISCC EU certification requirements pertaining to 203 Traceability and Chain of Custody (version 4.1) applicable to Peninsula Petroleum Limited (“PPL”), Peninsula Petroleum S.L. (“PPSL”), Peninsula Petroleum (Netherlands) B.V (“PPNL”) and Peninsula Petroleum Panama Inc (“PP Panama”) I hereby confirm that:

1. Compliance with the sustainability and greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions saving criteria per Renewable Energy Directive (EU) 2018/2001 (“RED II”) relies on certification of every element of a supply chain via traceability and chain of custody requirements.
2. The transfer of sustainability characteristics along the supply chain must always be accompanied by a physical transfer of material.
3. As a certified operator under ISCC EU, we are required to meet minimum requirements for the management system and documents such as Proof of Sustainability and/or Sustainability Declarations
4. Peninsula Petroleum Limited is committed to a Mass Balancing approach as its chosen chain of custody method and conducts its associated processes in accordance with the rules governing this approach.
5. Sustainability characteristics of a specific amount of sustainable material can only be used once and for one application only, and that multiple accounting under more than one certification regime is prohibited under ISCC EU rules.

Any deviations from the above will be treated as serious incident and investigated immediately per internal procedures (incl. notification to ISCC where required).
